Klaruw launch new prototype shot-blasting machine

Klaruw has launched a prototype shot-blasting machine which has just been trialled in the UK. The machine retextures the road surface to restore skid-resistance to compliant, safe levels.



Klaruw's UK contracting arm, Klaruw RMS, spoke at our Wiltshire Council-hosted UK Roads "Road Show" in March, at the Warrington offices of Atkins and the Southampton offices of Mott MacDonald in May and at the Perth offices of Transerv in June.

Klaruw believes that the new prototype is the only steel shot-blasting machine in the world that can work in wet conditions, has no hot spot, and where the intensity can be adjusted perpendicular to the direction of movement.
